GRADUATE STUDIES ADMISSIONS

1. Complete the graduate application at applytexas.org.
2. Pay the non-refundable application fee via your electronic application, or pay by cash, check, money order, or credit card in our Business Office.
3. Submit a 200-300 word essay addressing career and academic goals.
4. Request and/ or submit final official transcripts from all institutions previously attended. Coursework consolidated on one transcript does not meet this requirement.
5. Scores on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) or Graduate Record Exam (GRE) may be required. These scores should be sent directly to the Graduate Office by the testing service.

Beyond general requirements for admission to Graduate Studies, departments may set additional standards for admission to degree programs. Please contact the Office of Graduate Studies for additional graduate admission requirements.

Applicants may be considered for admission as further defined by the Office of Graduate Admissions policies.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Office of Student Financial Assistance helps students meet their educational expenses while attending Texas A&M University-Central Texas.
